A Nurse Aide - or Care Nurse, as the position is titled at Clarview - is a very caring person who sees the purpose in his/her life as giving care and assistance to residents so they may be comfortable, safe, and in the best state of wellness that they can be. Our Care Nurses always work under the supervision of a licensed nurse. If you are selected to join our Nurse Aide Training Class, you will join Clarview as an employee when orientation and the class begin.

The training will prepare you to sit for the certification exam and, upon passing, become a Nursing Assistant at Clarview. If selected, the following are covered by Clarview:

- PAID training.
- PAID exam fees.
- PAID full-time wages during training.
- PAID increased wage once you pass the certification exam.
- PAID pre-employment drug testing, physicals and background checks as required by the Department of Education.

DETAILS

- Monday 11/11/19 thru Tuesday 12/10/19. No class on WED 11/27, THURS 11/28 and FRI 11/29.
- Class, lab and clinical will be from 7AM to 3PM each scheduled day onsite at our Route 68 location above.
- Students cannot miss class during the first 3 days and cannot miss more than 2 total days. Clinical days missed
 must be made up and are based on the availability of the instructor.
- Students must wear scrubs (top and pants) and have a wristwatch with a second hand.
- Students are expected to dress for success, be well-groomed, prompt, and engaged in learning.

NURSE AIDE TASKS

Measuring and recording vital signs; bathing, dressing, and toileting; catheter care; feeding/serving residents; range of motion exercises; assisting with turning and positioning; assist in transporting residents in wheelchairs and ambulation with walkers and canes; bed making and keeping resident belongings neat and organized; infection control and safety awareness. Most importantly, talking with and listening to our residents!
